### OVERVIEW

For a number of years, Greylock has served as a "Leader for Change" with the YWCA-Charleston (YW). This means the company provides a sustaining-level of funding for the YW's varied programs, serving the most vulnerable in our community. In addition, our Team Members contribute their time, gifts, and talents to the YW through service. A member of senior management serves on the agency's board of directors and has also served as president of the board. Another employee serves on a committee for the YW and the CEO and his family have prepared and served meals at the YW's homeless shelter and annually provide holiday presents to children residing at Sojourner's Shelter.

### IMPROVING LIVES

#### Helping the Homeless

Greylock's support benefits the YW's Sojourner's Shelter for homeless women and families - giving shelter to the homeless, food to the hungry, and hope to the hopeless.

#### Providing Safe Respite for Survivors of Domestic Violence

Greylock's continued support benefits the YW's Resolve Family Abuse Program, which provides emergency shelter, counseling, and support for survivors of domestic violence.

#### Supporting Communities for Survivors of Elder Abuse

The company's support benefits residents of the Shanklin Center, a community providing permanent housing to survivors of elder abuse. In addition, a group of Team Members organize and host a holiday luncheon for the residents each December, complete with festive treats, presents, and plenty of holiday cheer.
